This year, we're inviting youth around the globe to join us on a journey towards a more peaceful world.

Our theme for this year focuses on peace and compassion across three dimensions:

- Peace Within (mindfulness and self-compassion)
- Peace With Others (compassion and understanding across differences)
- Peace Around the World (addressing conflict through connection and collaboration).


tools and materials

incentives

We've introduced incentives to encourage and support participation in the project.

- Teams will have the opportunity to receive a \$25 or \$50 gift cards through DonorsChoose.
- Teams that have submitted plans for their creative expression can opt in for consideration,
- 100-200 total teams will be randomly selected to receive a gift card.
- 25-50 teams will be selected each month from November through February.










LIVE tRaining & SUPPORT

- We'll offer direct project support, enabling teachers to get guidance from Creative Visions.
- There will be four 60-90 minute Zoom training sessions covering an introduction to Students Rebuild, teaching youth about philanthropy, using the program for Days of Service, and implementing it outside traditional classrooms.
